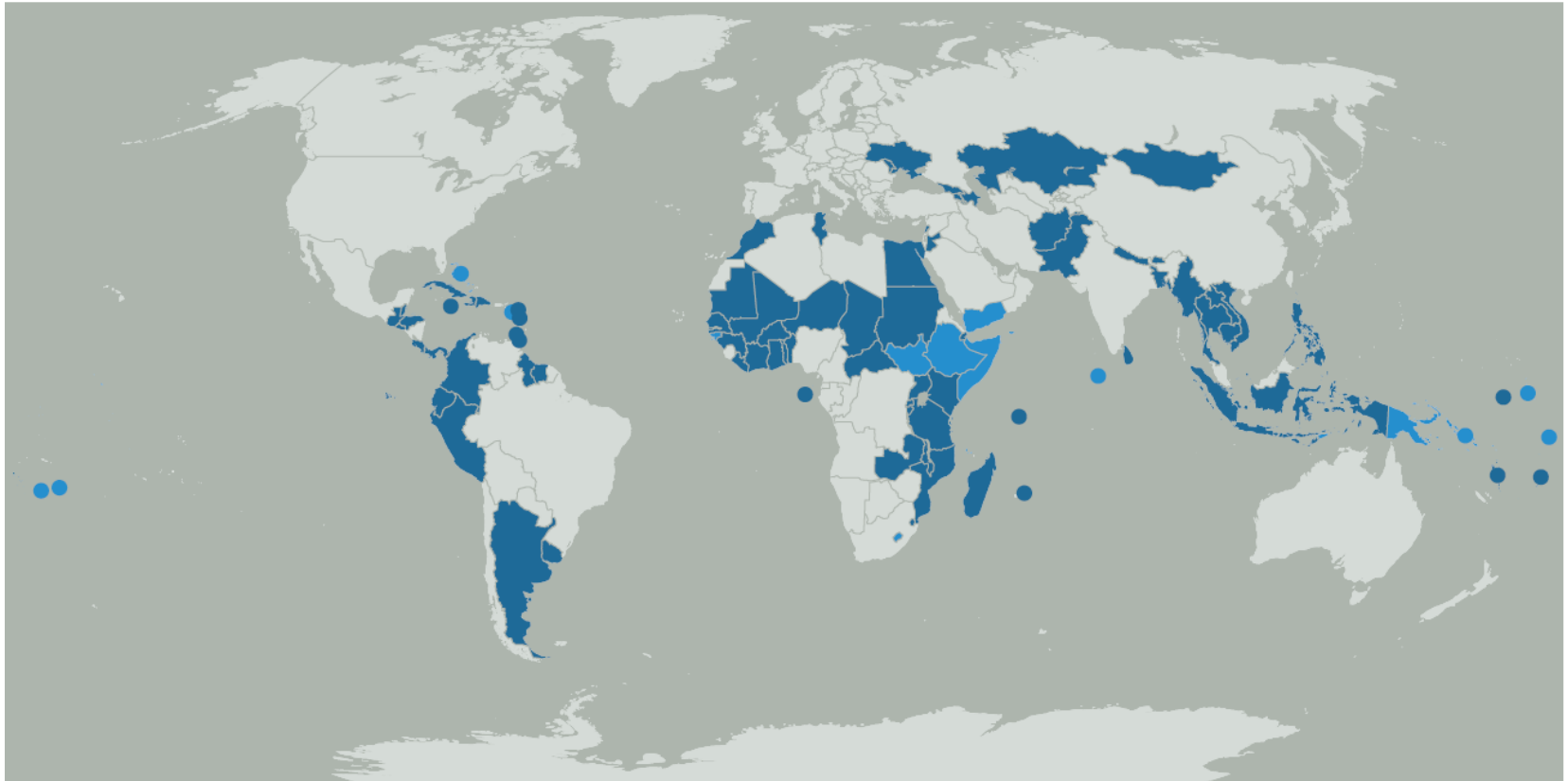
What are the Technology Needs Assessments?

implemented by UN Environment through UNEP DTU Partnership*

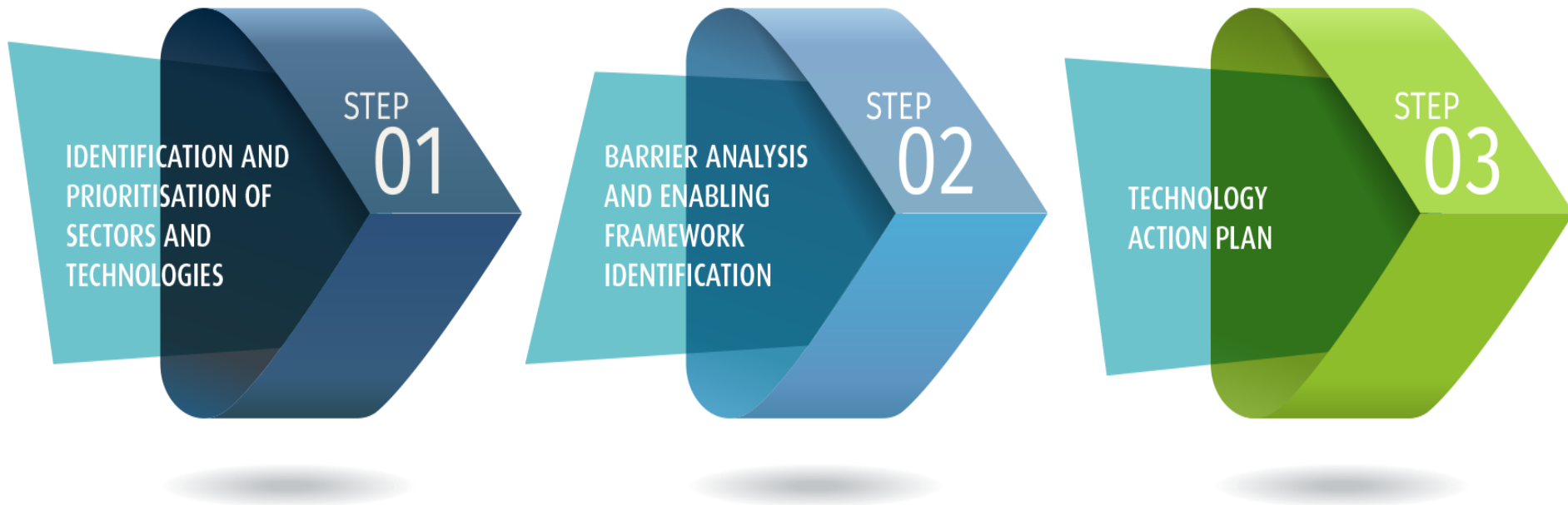
Technology Needs Assessment countries (2009 – till date)



● TNA Countries

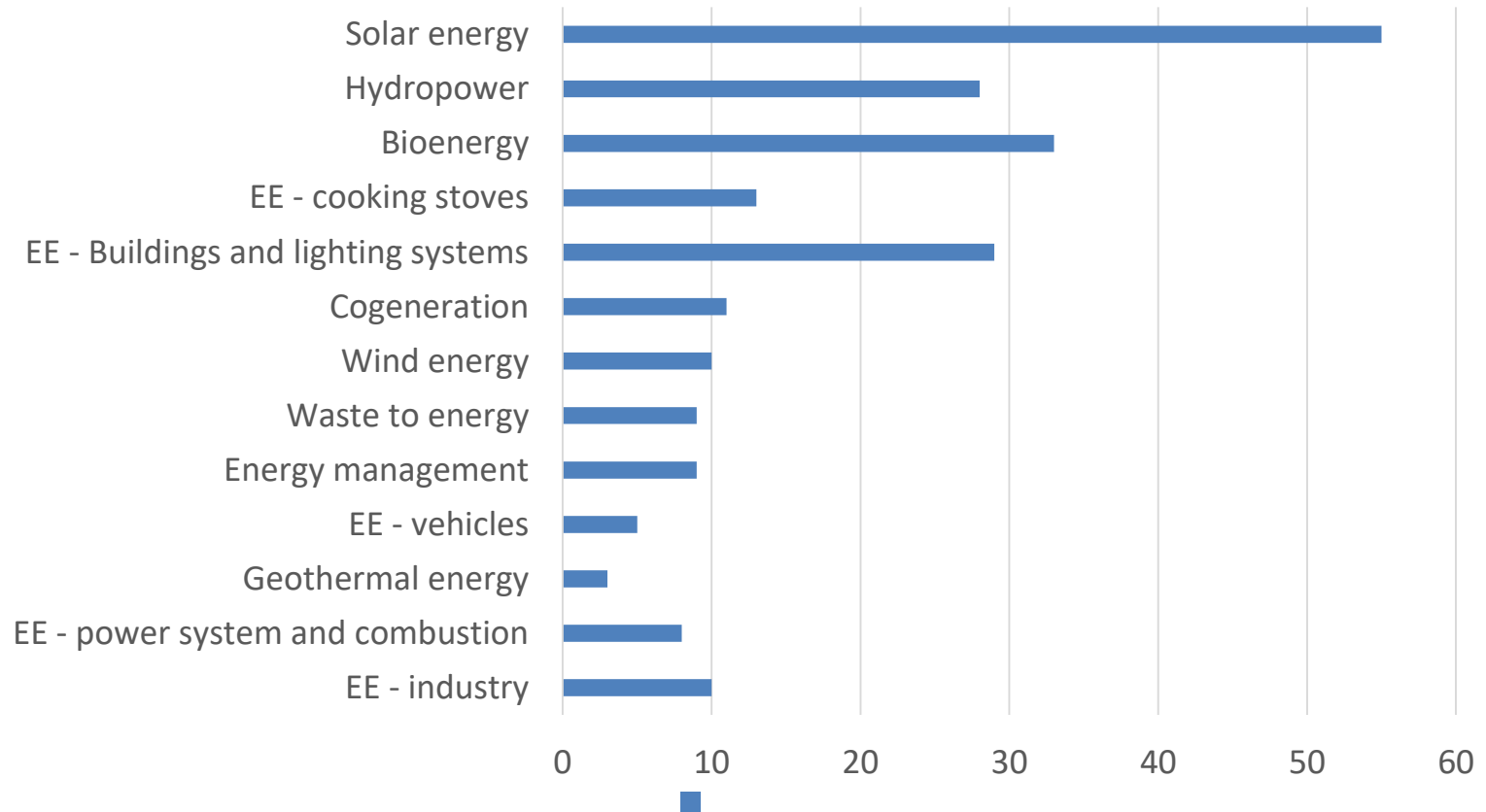
