

The City of Glasgow

- Scotland's largest city: 626,000 (city),
 1.8M (city region)
- Powerhouse of the Scottish economy: £42.8bn GVA (30% of the Scottish economy)
- Diverse economy;
 - Digital Technology, Creative Economy, Low Carbon Industries, Life Sciences, Engineering Design and Advanced Manufacturing, Finance and Business Services, Higher and Further Education, Tourism
- UNESCO City of Music
- UN Global Green City, Carbon neutrality target for 2030
- Host city for UN Climate Change Conference 2021 (COP26)

The Thriving Space Sector

- 18% of UK space sector employment in Scotland
- More satellites produced in Glasgow than any other city located outside of the United States

 - Bird.i
- Scottish Centre of Excellence for Space Applications and Space Business Incubator
- Increase growth expected with the creation of two UK Spaceports in Scotland;
 - Shetland Space Centre
 - Space Hub Sutherland





The Future City Demonstrator

- £24M Innovate UK "Future Cities Demonstrator"
- Programme delivered in two years 2013-2014
- Creation of
 - the "Glasgow Operations Centre"
 - the "Open Glasgow" City Data Platform
- Delivery of City Demonstrators;
 - Smart Energy
 - Active Travel
 - Intelligent Street Lighting
 - Smart Mobility
 - IP CCTV





Beyond the Demonstrator

- Large-scale deployment of Intelligent Street Lighting across the whole of the city centre (3,700 street lights)
- 14 acre Smart Campus programme
- Smart Street Project (H2020 Ruggedised)
- Smart Canal
- 3D Urban Model
- 99% LoRaWAN coverage
- New Centres of Excellence
 - Centre for Data Analytics
 - Centre for Civic Innovation
